



## **GBOCA Va'a Grant Programme Term Sheet**

### **Goals of the Programme**

- Establish *new* outrigger canoe clubs in Great Britain.
- Develop outrigger canoeing in Great Britain.
- Help execute the GBOCA four-year strategic plan.

### **Requirements**

For the length of the grant period, outrigger canoe clubs must:

- Be legally established as a company limited by Guarantee or a registered Club (e.g. CASC).
- Be GBOCA-affiliated
- Ensure outrigger canoe club members are full members of GBOCA
- Agree a contractual guarantee of responsibility for any damage or theft (an insurance policy may cover this).
- Store the canoe in a suitable location agreed by GBOCA
- Be inclusive of all (all ages and abilities)
- Demonstrate to GBOCA how they will develop outrigger canoeing in their region.

### **Terms of Use**

The outrigger canoe offered in the programme is the FAI V6 that was used at the 2017 World Distance Championship. It is not brand new.

The outrigger canoe will be leased to own for four years. The club will commit to making four equal payments of £1,500 (total £4,500).

The outrigger canoe can be called back to GBOCA for use at National Events during the four-year lease period. (The club must transport or arrange transport of the canoe to national events as requested).

The outrigger canoe will be respected and maintained at all times and the canoe will not be painted or physically altered in any way during the grant period, except for the addition of stickers or decals which identify the club.

Any damage to the outrigger canoe, ama or iakos will be reported to GBOCA within 3 days of the date of damage and professionally repaired at the club's expense by a repairer approved by GBOCA.

If the canoe, ama or iakos is damaged beyond repair, the club is responsible for repaying any outstanding amounts owed.

GBOCA will provide coaching and training to club steerers.



**If the Club fails to make its annual payment by the agreed date, the club will forfeit its right to the canoe and any amount already paid will not be refunded.**

### **Supporting Documents**

The following evidence is required to complete the application

- Club by-laws or constitution;
- Documents of legal establishment;
- Description/ map of storage location;
- Insurance documents or personal guarantee;
- Development plan for the new outrigger canoe club, addressing each section of the GBOCA 4-year strategic plan
